Application of all liquid manure within 1000 feet of any residence, business, church or school shall be done by injection or incorporation.

Manure must be incorporated into soil, CAFOs must have odor control plan that addresses dust and particulates as well as odors. CAFOs must use one in a list of odor control technologies. 1) All surface spread manure must be incorporated within 24 hours unless applied to a growing crop .

Ordinance provides reduced setbacks when listed odor controls are implemented. No application to frozen ground or flood prone areas. No application when rain is forecast. Liquid manure shall not be applied at a rate that exceeds the infiltration rate of the soils or that causes the ponding of liquids on the surface. Manure applied within 1000 feet of a residence must be incorporated. The Health Department shall not issue a permit to any person that: 1. Has an unresolved violation with the EPA, IDEM, the Health Department or any other environmental regulatory agency concerning a CAFO, 2. Has intentionally misrepresented or concealed any material fact in any application for a County permit applicable to the proposed CAFO, or 3. Has knowingly and repeatedly violated any county, state, or federal environmental protection laws concerning a CAFO.
